




- Comprehensive evaluation plan

- Parallels with 1.2: systematic, evidence of regular implementation
- Different from 1.2: flexibility













#### Assessment of strengths and weaknesses related to this criterion and plans for improvement in his area, if applicable



#### Next steps

- Comments due to CEPH by COB on May 16
- Stay tuned in early/mid July for next draft!
- Next comment period in summer to early fall—likely due date in mid-September
- Anticipated release of criteria & implementation plan in late Oct – early Nov
  - Implementation plan will explain what you need to do & by when
  - 1<sup>st</sup> SVs with new criteria will likely be in 2018
  - More info coming in July with updated draft


