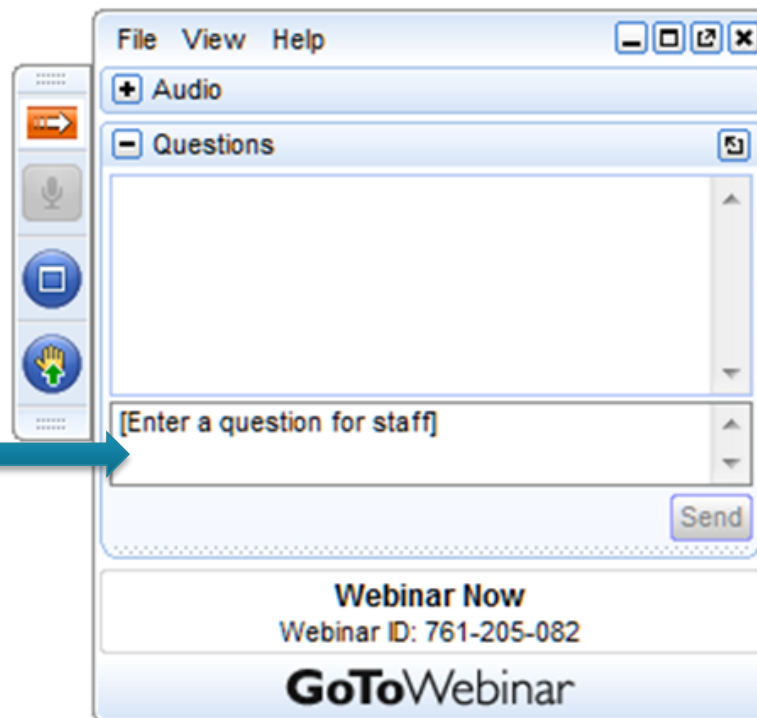

Institutional Aid

- * Merit – GPA, test scores, etc.
- * Need – Estimated Family Contribution (EFC)
- * Mission – Evidence of, or intention to, serving underserved populations in the field of Public Health

Sources of Institutional Aid

- * Scholarships/Grants
- * Teaching Assistantships
- * Research Assistantships

Carefully check and adhere to criteria and deadline dates listed on institution's website

Search Strategies

- * Search Early - Deadline dates Oct./Nov./Dec. prior to application deadline dates
- * Search Often– new funding sources become available on a regular basis
- * Search for related sources and vary search terminology
- * Solicit organizations or groups you are affiliated with: i.e., religious, social, or service.
- * Expand network – solicit friends/family to help in the search

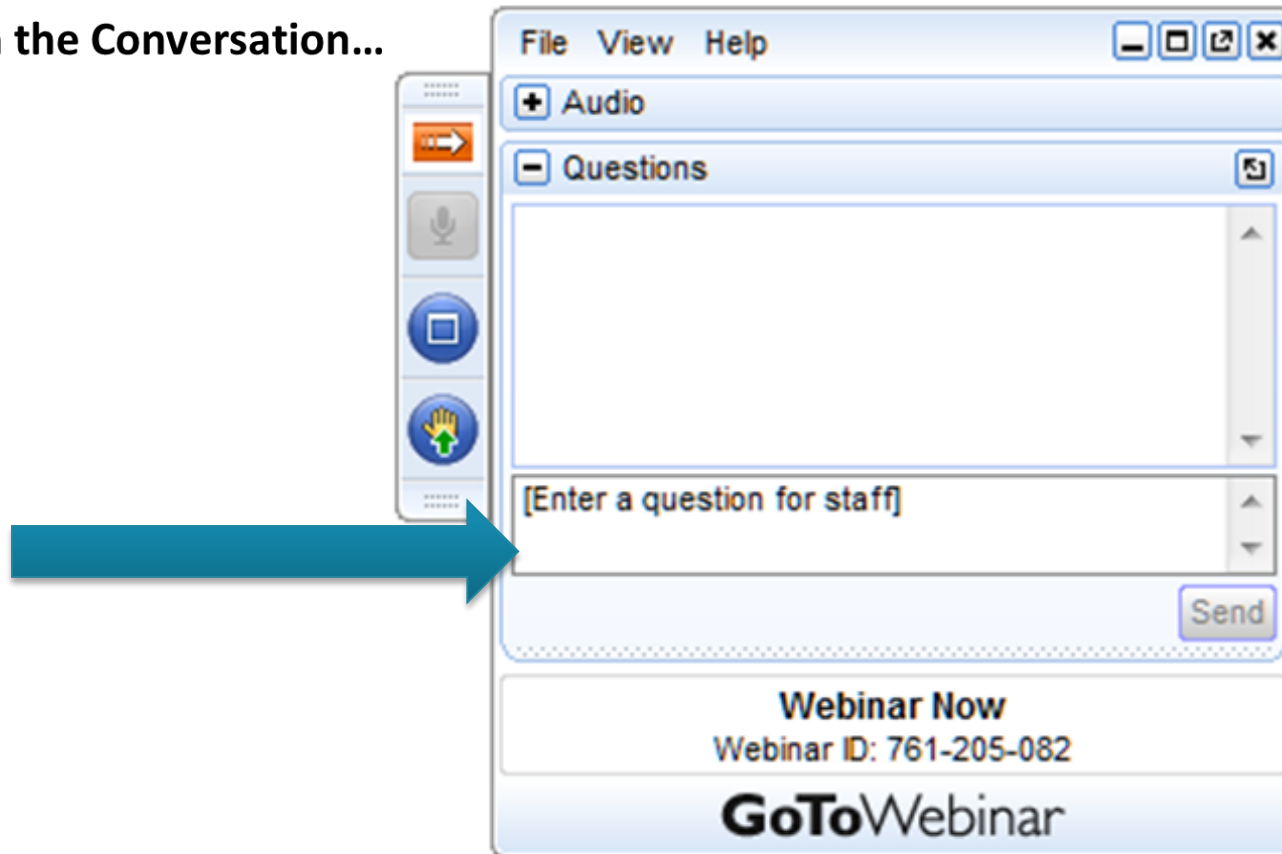
