## **PROGRAM FACULTY AND DETAILS**

The APHLI Advanced Leadership Program is led by faculty from the Center for Creative Leadership (CCL). CCL, a global leader in executive education, draws on decades of experience in developing top leaders in academia and public health.

### **NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES**

ASPPH is **now accepting nominations** for candidates to attend the APHLI Advanced Leadership Program. **Nominations will be accepted through April 1, 2020**.

Please note that only the dean or director of an ASPPH-member school or program of public health may nominate a candidate, and only one nomination per institution will be accepted. Requests for nominations have been sent directly to each ASPPH-member dean and director.

#### The Advanced Leadership Program fee: \$5,500

- Executive coaching
- On-demand leadership resources *Travel-related costs are not included.*

ASPPH is offering 50% fee deferment to 2021, and a limited number of partial scholarship opportunities.
